Welcome! We at the Global Journal of Community Psychology Practice are thrilled you are considering submitting video highlighting your practice or documenting your practice in action!

Video submissions will not be subject to blind peer-review, although the editorial board may solicit input from others when working with the submitter to improve the format and content of the submission.

How To Submit a Video

Create and post a web-version of the video. If your video is longer than 20 minutes, create a 3-5 minute excerpt of the video. Post the web-version of your video to YouTube.com or another video-hosting site (see Video FAQ's for more details).

Create a thumbnail photo or select a still image that represents the video content and include that in your e-mail submission.

By submitting a video to the GJCPP, you certify that you hold all copyrights to the material submitted.

The review panel will view your video. If the video is accepted for publication as a feature, we will contact you with next steps.

GJCPP Video Submission FAQ's:

Q. What Kind Of Videos Can I Submit?

A. You are encouraged to submit any video that is connected to the mission of GJCPP. This may include instructional videos, interviews, documentaries, or community-produced videos. Please refrain from submitting videos whose sole purpose is to advertise a product or organization, or whose content is misleading or offensive.

Q. How Do I Submit A Video to the Journal?

A. See step-by-step instructions above.

Q. Which Video-Sharing Site Should I Use?

A. We recommend using YouTube (<http://www.youtube.com>) for all short-form (10-min or less) videos and excerpts. Because YouTube limits the size of videos to 1GB, you may wish to use an alternative site, such as Google Video (<http://video.google.com>), Pandora.tv (<http://www.pandora.tv>), or OurMedia.org (<http://www.ourmedia.org>).

Q. How Do I Select a Thumbnail Image for the Video?

A. Most sites will allow you to easily select a thumbnail image from your video. Instructions for how to select a thumbnail image on YouTube can be found here:
